Public forum regarding agenda items only – One thing is added on the agendaauthorize Supervisor to forward completed MET Tower application from Borrego Solar Systems after legal recuse.

<u>Highway Report</u> – (Dale Root) –Read and presented report of the past month to town clerk. Some of his highlights: the Highway Dept. is continuing to cold patch pot holes on good weather days. Trees are also in the process of being removed with the help of the villages chipper. He is getting a lot of signatures on

release forms to remove trees. He would like to recommend the highway dept. to look into the purchase of a bucket truck. The county is coming in with their bucket truck but there are so many more to do. A large pile of brush from a storm clean up awhile back has been completed. Finished assembling new fenders for the big loader. A price of \$3800 had been given from a dealer but the highway dept. built them for under \$500 out of aluminum. They were power coated and have been installed. Work was done on truck 657. The road widener has been repaired. A missing road sign has been installed and another one repaired. Assisted the Village of Lyndonville twice to locate and pinpoint a water leak. Went on road survey with Lee from Suit-Kote to assess all town roads. He would like to work with the board to devise a 5 year plan. Required water test to Erie County from Job Corps location. From previous discussions between the board and himself it is becoming more evident to seek a source of funding to begin closing up our dead end lines. Flushing dead end lines require a lot of waste water so as to comply with county standards. With all the water flushes that function, together with new rates he will try to put a new value on it. He has talked to Scott Mattison from MRB Group on this. Three men attended water school last week. Dale signed an Emergency Shared Service Agreement with NYSDOT. In the event of such emergency, equipment will be used to best serve. The state may plow to Niagara County where as we may do their route. This is the first year this agreement has been offered to the town. There is no cost to the town.
