

**Order to Establish Lighting District
For Furnace Parkway**

Whereas, the Town of Shelby has received a petition dated September 27, 2022 signed by residents of 18 households owning more than one-half of the taxable real property on located Furnace Parkway to establish a lighting district; and

Whereas, street lighting is currently installed along the length of Furnace Parkway, Shelby, New York, requiring no construction or acquisition of improvements to create the lighting district.

Now therefore, the Town Board of the Town of Shelby, hereby adopts the following order:

1. The Town Board was presented with a petition, signed by the owners owning more than half of the taxable real property value along the length of Furnace Parkway, Shelby, New York, seeking to establish a lighting district along, and coextensive with, the distance between the eastern most and western most boundaries of Furnace Parkway, Shelby, New York.
2. Street lighting has previously been installed on Furnace Parkway and no additional construction costs shall be required to establish the Furnace Parkway Lighting District. Residents of the Furnace Parkway Lighting District shall be responsible for any and all charges made upon the Town for cost to the utility company, currently National Grid, to operate and maintain the street lights in the Furnace Parkway Lighting District.
3. The Furnace Parkway Lighting District shall be considered an *ad valorem* district and, upon creation of such lighting district, a levy charge shall be imposed on the benefited real property of the lighting district in the same manner and at the same time as taxes for municipal purposes, which shall defray the cost of the lighting district.
4. A public hearing shall be held on December 13, 2022 at 6:30 pm at the Shelby Town Hall, 4062 Saltworks Road, Medina, New York
